BUSINESS DEVELOPMENT

ITI Business Development was developed to help union sheet metal workers who are considering going into business for themselves, to prepare for the challenges involved in becoming SMART union contractors.

In this course participants will start by asking themselves some important questions: Am I ready to own my own business? Do I have what it takes? If I do this, what are the risks? What will be the rewards? Once they decide that they've got the skills, personality, and support to take on this exciting opportunity, they will learn about the many details they will need to address to get their businesses off the ground.

Because planning is an essential part of running a business or a project, ITI Business Development introduces participants to the tools they need to plan for successful business ownership from carefully choosing a business name, to hiring and keeping the right people, to bidding accurately, to keeping track of cash flow and more. This program will give the participant a jump-start on writing a comprehensive business plan along with exposure to essential marketing and financing strategies used in today's construction and service markets.

This program is offered in 4 remote sessions. Each session is 2 hours (dependent upon class participation) with approximately 2 hours of independent study per week.

Computer System Requirements:

We recommend using a headset plugged into your computer, or headphones with a mic plugged into you mobile device.
